North Dakota has the most stringent laws, requiring a court order for even a 23-hour hold.

Voluntary admissions usually require a 72-hour holding period for professional evaluation. Once the 72-hour hold is lifted, patients can request a discharge or further care. Minors can sign themselves into a voluntary hold in an emergency, but the legal guardian must be notified within 24 hours.

Emergency hospitalization for evaluation is a crisis response in which a patient is admitted to a treatment facility for psychiatric evaluation, typically for a short period of fixed time (e.g., 72 hours). "Psychiatric hold" or "pick-up" and other terms may be used to describe the process.

(e) A person held under a 72-hour emergency hold must be released by the facility within 72 hours unless a court order to hold the person is obtained. A consecutive emergency hold order under this section may not be issued.

This issue brief addresses the state's emergency mental health hold procedure, which allows for a person to be involuntarily held for a 72-hour period of treatment and evaluation if he or she appears to have a mental illness and, due to the mental illness, appears to be an imminent danger to self or others, or appears to be gravely disabled.
