Examination of the ways the term was applied revealed that an occupational perspective encompasses a common assumption that occupation is "a way to enable health through occupation" (Wilcock, 2001, p. 417) and "occupational aspects [are] of importance for health and development" (Hemmingsson & Jonsson, 2005, p. 572).
