### 10.1 Overview of Muscle Tissues - Anatomy and Physiology ...

Skeletal muscle consists of long cylindrical cells that, under a microscope, appear striated with bands perpendicular to the length of the cell. The many nuclei in each cell (multinucleated cells) are located near the outside along the plasma membrane, which is called the sarcolemma. Skeletal muscle is attached to bones and causes movements of the body.
