### **Brooding - Poultry Hub**

Place the brooder in a place where the chicks can be warm, dry, and safe. Keep it out of the elements. For bedding, don't use newspaper and stick with pine shavings instead of cedar shavings. Cedar can release oils. You'll want to spread about an inch of bedding on the floor. A heat lamp should go in the brooder on one end of the brooder.

### **How to Use a Chicken Brooder - The Spruce**

Chicks can be brooded together within 2 weeks of age. You can also use the amount of feathering to determine if different age chicks can be placed together. If the chicks I have brooding currently have all their wing feathers, then I don't introduce baby chicks to that brooder. Over all, use common sense.

Radiant or infrared brooders come with two major types of radiant elements: a small ceramic disk or large stainless steel cone. Six panels make a 37" diameter brooder. Seven panels make a 50" diameter brooder. If you are going to place the Heat Lamp Stand in the brooder, you will need 5 panels total in order for the stand to fit inside the brooder.
