How to Choose What Level of HSC English to Take in Year 11 ...

In the HSC, all students for English Standard and English Advanced do the common paper – Area of Study. The remainder of the courses are quite different in levels of difficulty. This means that students' marks from their standard exams and assessments are not going to be equal to those of their peers who do Advanced English.

English Paper 1 is a two-hour examination (plus 10 minutes reading time) usually conducted on the first day of the HSC exams. The paper is common to both English (Standard) and English (Advanced) students and is thus the most widely sat HSC exam. English Paper 1 tests the Area of Study through three questions:
