Khat (*catha edulis*) is a natural stimulant from the *catha edulis* plant, found in the flowering evergreen tree or large shrub of Celastraceae family, which grows mainly in Yemen, Ethiopia, Somalia, Kenya, Saudi Arabia, and at high altitude areas in South Africa and Madagascar. The plant is known by different names in different countries: Qat in Yemen, Khat in Ethiopia, Mirra in Kenya and Qaad or Jaad in Somalia, but in most of the literature it is known as khat.
