One model may look like this: The consignment period lasts 90 days, with a 25 percent markdown after 30 days and a 50 percent discount after 60 days. This is also the place to note your pickup and donation policy of unsold items. Also, clearly state your consignment terms. A 60/40 store split is the most common.

While there isn't a law requiring ecommerce stores to have a Return Policy, you may need one if you wish to enforce your terms and parameters of returns and refunds.. For example, in the state of New York, if a retailer does not provide a Return & Refund Policy, the retailer will be required to accept returns and give refunds for all merchandise returned within 30 days of purchase.
