The main "trick" is to paint the figures as if you were dressing them, from the bottom up. Start from the layer most underneath, usually the skin. Use the largest brush you can for the job (I tend to use a number 2 for this), don't worry about having paint going all over the figures, that's fine.

Then I start painting using a factory line technique. In other words, I paint by unit, eg, a 12 figure EMPIRE battalion. I paint the same single color across all figures before going to the next color. For mounted troops, I paint all horses first, while for artillery units, I complete the gun carriages and wheels first.

The actual paint job can be infinitely simplified by one simple method: paint your figures in the same way you would put on clothes in the morning. This means that you start with the first layer - the birthday suit (aka all exposed flesh) and go on the the next layer, the undershirt. After that, you do the overshirt, armor, or jacket, etc.

## **Painting miniatures: A beginner's guide - Polygon**

Once the figures are clean and dry, apply a thin base coating of an appropriate undercoat, one which will adhere to metal and allow you to paint on top with acrylic paints. You will usually get a better finish using spray undercoats. Choose the undercoat color based on your intended paint scheme.
