The case was settled in the autumn of 1928, before the trial was deliberated by the jury, and the settlement for each of the Radium Girls was \$10,000 (equivalent to \$149,000 in 2019) and a \$600 per year annuity (equivalent to \$8,900 in 2019) plus \$12 a week (equivalent to \$200 in 2019) for all of their lives while they lived, and all medical and legal expenses incurred would also be paid by the company.

Though they were paid piecemeal, the girls could make a lot of money — “some even earned more than their fathers.” For working class young women in Newark like Katherine Schaub, it was exciting.

Radium's luminosity was part of its allure, and the dial painters soon became known as the "ghost girls" — because by the time they finished their shifts, they themselves would glow in the dark.
