The Community & Urban Forestry program is a partner with the Tree City USA program. In 2018, Indiana has 63 Tree City USA Communities, 11 Tree Campus USA Schools, and five Tree Line USA Utilities. Requirements of becoming a Tree City USA include: Appoint a tree board or city department to manage the tree care program. Have or pass a public tree care ordinance. Spend a minimum of \$2 per capita on a community forestry program. Have an Arbor Day proclamation and hold an Arbor Day event. 2018 ...

Delaware's Urban and Community Forestry Program offers annual grants up to \$5,000 for tree planting or tree management projects on public land. The competitive grants - open to all municipalities, homeowner associations, and certified 501 (c) (3) non-profits in the State of Delaware - require a 50-50 match in either cash (non-federal funds) or in-kind services, which includes volunteer or staff time, equipment rental, or supplies.
