Infectious Disease & Non-Infectious Disease Infectious diseases, including HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, polio, and several neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) are easily spread through personal contact, water, and air, (many NTDs are vector borne – transmitted by mosquitoes, flies, etc) and are a particularly significant problem in developing countries.

Infectious Disease & Non-Infectious Disease

An infectious disease caused by a living microorganism A noninfectious disease (disorder) due to other living or nonliving factors Living: fungi, bacteria, viruses, nematodes Living: insects, mites, snails, rats, birds, weeds, etc. Nonliving: temperature, moisture, sunlight, wind, nutrient deficiency or toxicity, mowers, chemicals, etc.

Infectious vs. Noninfectious Diseases

What is the difference between an infectious disease and a noninfectious disease? Students should recognize that infectious diseases are caused by pathogens such as viruses, bacteria, and parasites and can be spread by direct contact or through vectors. Noninfectious diseases cannot be “caught” from other humans or animals.

3 Viruses Go "Viral" | Infectious Diseases

All inactivated (killed) viral vaccines (e.g., rabies, CIV) and bacterial vaccines are noninfectious (e.g., leptospirosis, *Borrelia burgdorferi* [canine Lyme disease], canine influenza virus, and parenteral B. bronchiseptica vaccines). 9

Vaccine types - AAHA

Non-infectious diseases are not caused by pathogens and therefore cannot be spread from one person to another. Instead, non-infectious diseases are caused by factors such as genetics, malnutrition, environment and lifestyle. Examples of non-infectious diseases include cancer, Alzheimer's disease and epilepsy.

Why is this? First, in many non-infectious disease cluster investigations, an apparent geographic or temporal excess in the number of cases cannot be confirmed. In part that is because many non-infectious diseases reported as clusters (e.g., cancers, birth defects) are common in the community, and supposed clusters reflect normal disease patterns.
