This book is less a philosophical work of Theology, but more of a technical analysis of the subject matter, applying rules of logic and reason and bringing to bear knowledge of scientific fact, while also carefully examining all that the scripture tells us on the issue, without cherry-picking or eisegesis. But we can only get to what He is trying to communicate by letting scripture interpret scripture, taking it as literal as possible (as warranted by the text itself), in its most natural sense. In the case of symbology, which is used extensively in this book of Revelation, again we find the symbolism interpreted elsewhere in scripture. In some cases it helps to apply what we know from the real world, in terms of science, geopolitics and history. And we must recognize and incorporate supernatural explanations where they are invoked or necessarily implied or inferred in scripture, but not where literal natural explanations are available and for good reason preferred.
