(And) a portion of it was barren which could neither hold the water nor bring forth vegetation (then that land gave no benefits). Using methods and perspectives borrowed from biblical studies, Shoemaker concludes that these reports of Muhammad's leadership during the Palestinian invasion likely preserve an early Islamic tradition that was later revised to meet the needs of a changing Islamic self-identity.
